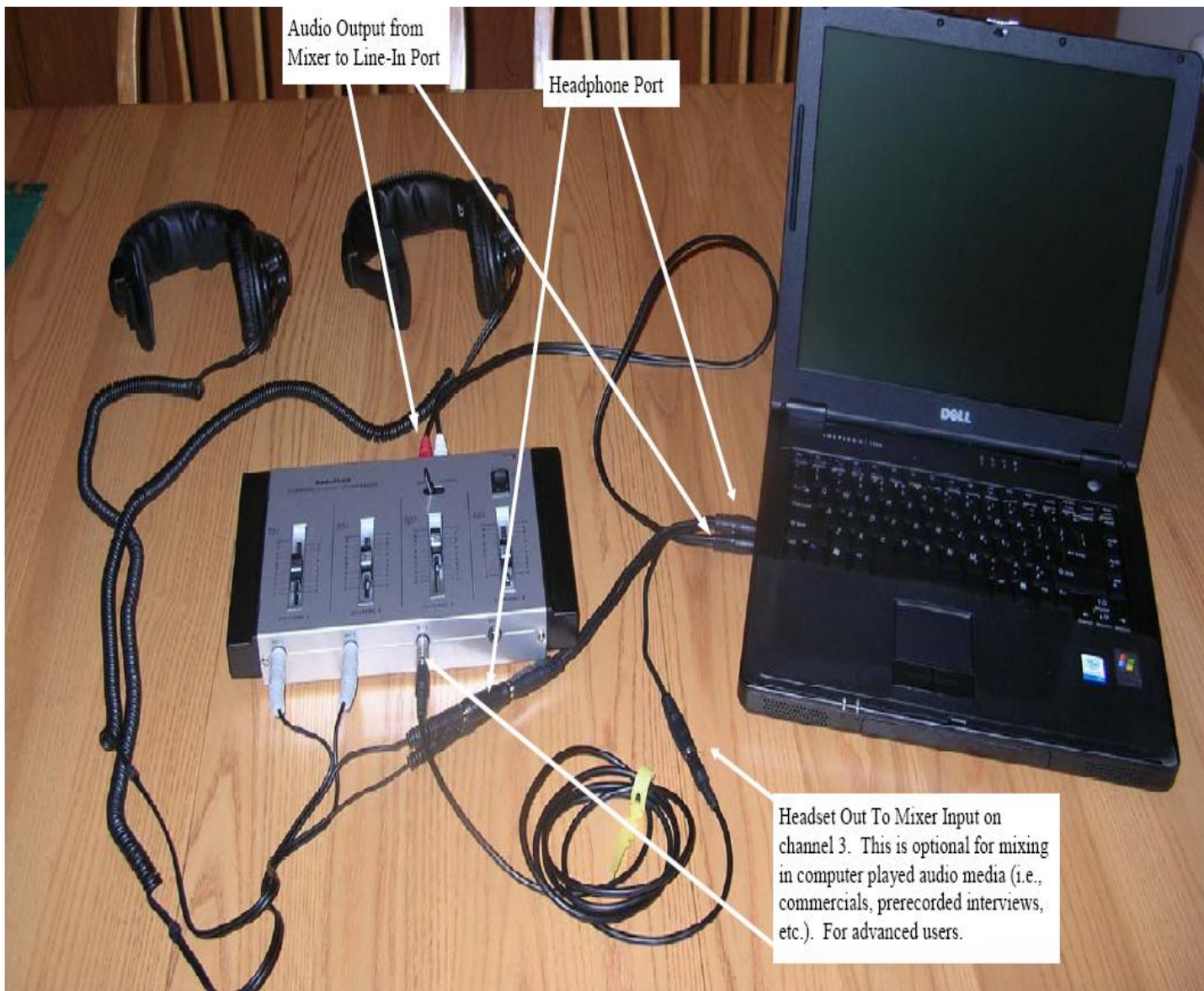




Common Set Up



This is the basic setup. The mixer has four channels. Above is using channels 1, 2, and 3, although this setup is not mandatory. The gray plugs from the headsets are the mic inputs. They go into the mixer, each plugging into one channel of the mixer. The black plugs from the headsets are the headphones and they go into a three-way splitter that is plugged into the headphone port. This can optionally be a two-way splitter without using channel 3 per notes above.

Note: Ports on laptops are likely not in the same spot on all computers. Just know that the headsets plug into the headset port, which is marked. And the audio output plugs into the line-in port. The last hookup is the third port on the headset splitter. This is optional and shows running an audio cable from the laptop headset output into the mixer. This is to mix commercials externally, with commercials playing on the computer using Media Player, into the stream using the external mixer. The audio cable goes into the 3rd channel on the mixer. There are other ways to do this, including using an external CD player, MP3 player, or internally on the laptop.
